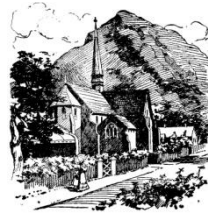

PRAYER BEFORE MASS: Father in heaven, may all who share in the sonship of Christ follow in his path of service to man, and reflect the glory of his kingdom even to the ends of the earth, for he is Lord for ever and ever.

PROPER OF THE MASS (*Omnis terra*)

INTROIT: All the earth shall worship thee, O God, and sing of thee: they shall sing praise to thy name, O Most Highest. O be joyful in God, all ye lands: sing praises unto the honour of his name: make his praise to be glorious.

GRADUAL: The Lord sent his word and healed them: they were saved from their destruction. O that men would therefore praise the Lord for his goodness: and declare the wonders that he doeth for the children of men.

ALLELUIA: Alleluia. Alleluia. Praise the Lord, all ye angels of his: praise him, all his host. Alleluia.

OFFERTORY: O be joyful in God, all ye lands: sing praises unto the honour of his name. O come hither and hearken, all ye that fear God: and I will tell you what the Lord hath done for my soul.

COMMUNION: The Lord saith unto them: Fill the waterpots with water, and bear unto the governor of the feast. When the ruler of the feast had tasted the water that was made wine, he saith unto the bridegroom: Thou hast kept the good wine until now. This beginning of miracles did Jesus before his disciples.

FROM GELASIVS OF CYZICUS (5th CENTURY): At the divine table let us not stoop to fix attention on the bread and cup set forth; but by faith let us understand that on the sacred table is set the Lamb of God who taketh
